## **PARENT/CARERS OF THE PUPIL**

- I will check my child is fit to attend school each morning before bringing them.
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will keep to the 2m social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- I will observe safe social distancing rules and encourage other household members to do so.
- I will teach my child to use good respiratory hygiene and to wash their hands often.
- I will not come into the school with my child. I will email or telephone if I need to make an appointment.
- I will support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will encourage my child to complete home learning

## **THE SCHOOL**

### **The school will:**

- Welcome children back to school sensitively, allowing them time to adjust to new routines.
- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID19 infection.
- Support your child's wellbeing including giving them someone to talk to if they feel anxious or overwhelmed
- Adhere to the social distancing guidelines as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being and mental health.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to help children understand the new rules and routines.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19 so that they can be taken home and to self-isolate.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of Covid – 19, and help the NHS test and trace system get in touch with you if they test positive and the rest of the 'bubble' needs to self-isolate.
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, email, text messages and the school website.
- Provide remote learning that allows your child to access as much of the curriculum as possible if your child/child's 'bubble' has to self-isolate and make alternative arrangements if your child cannot access remote learning
