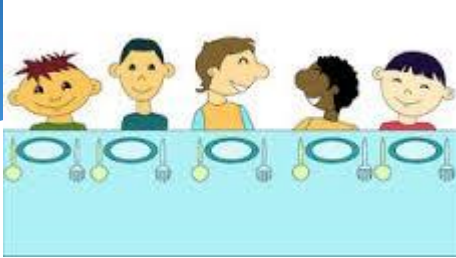

Where do we stay?



- Girls and boys will sleep in separate dormitories with attached teachers' bedrooms.
- Each building has a communal area/classroom.
- Each dormitory has an attached shower block.
- All bedding is included (duvet and cover, sheets, pillow and pillowcase, plastic mattress).
- Each building is locked at night and secured with an alarm.

- * Caterers provide a range of healthy and tasty meals during our stay.

Medical Information



- * Any prescribed medicine that your child needs must be clearly labelled with their name and careful instructions and must be given to the teacher, in writing, with regard to dosage and frequency by Tuesday 16th November 2021.
- * Travel sickness tablets - please give one before the departure and provide another, clearly labelled with name and instructions, for the return journey.
- * Sayers Croft have staff on site 24 hours a day.

Keeping in Contact

- * We will contact the school as soon as we arrive at Sayers Croft and will keep in contact throughout the duration of the stay.
- * Mrs Wilson may provide updates via text message
- * Parents will be informed if we are running late on the journey back to school

Tuck shop

- * Pupils can bring £5 pocket money. This needs to be put in a sealed envelope and given to the teachers at the start of the trip. This can be brought in to school from Monday 15th November 2021.
- * We will look after this after the visit to the tuck shop and for the remainder of the trip.

Valuables

- * Children should not be bringing any valuable equipment e.g. phones, digital cameras, music players, watches, jewellery, e-books, etc.
- * If they would like to bring a camera it must be disposable. The teachers will be taking lots of photos on the trip, so this is not necessary.
- * Teddies and paperback books can be brought along.

Behaviour

- * Whilst we are away high standards of behaviour are expected at all times.

Essentials

- * Wellies and lots of warm clothes
- * Waterproofs
- * Indoor and outdoor shoes
- * Plastic bags to put wet clothes, shoes, towels in

Payment

- * The total cost for the three day residential trip including accommodation, food and all activities is £60. The school pays for the cost of the coach.
- * Please log in to your School Gateway account at www.schoolgateway.com by Friday 1st October to give your consent for your child to attend and to pay a £10 deposit to secure your child's place. Once consent is given and your deposit made, we will be in touch regarding the **final payment of £50 which will be due no later than Friday 5th November.**
