

ENGLISH

Newspaper articles/reports based on fiction

This term, your child will be learning about the features of a newspaper report along with reported, direct and indirect speech. They will be learning how to use passive and active voice and changing between tenses. Their newspaper report will be based on our topic 'Wars of the World'.

MATHS

Your child will be developing their understanding of:

- Area and perimeter: calculating both area and perimeter of regular and irregular shapes, compound shapes and rectilinear shapes.
- Multiplication and division: multiplying and dividing numbers up to four digits by a one or two digit number using a formal written method.
- Fractions: identifying and writing equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators.

SCIENCE

This term, your child's topic is 'We are dinosaur hunters'. The national curriculum link is evolution and inheritance and we will be focusing on Biology. In particular, we will be learning about dinosaurs, fossils, adaptation, evolution and changes over time.

HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

WEEKLY HOMEWORK
