The Accidental Prime Minister

Swallows will be writing their own humorous narrative based on this book by Tom McLaughlin which links to our topic 'Law and Order'. We will be covering a range of writing techniques including similes, metaphors, conjunctions and fronted adverbials.

MATHS

Your child will be developing their understanding of:

- Multiplication and division using different representations including base ten and the bar model.
- Multiplying and dividing 1-digit and 2-digit numbers along with scaling.

- Identify different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions
- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

TOPIC

Law and Order is a thematic unit, based on the concept of justice, with a key focus on citizenship. We will look at the importance of leadership and the meaning of democracy and its origins, before moving on to how this applies practically in communities, both school-wide, locally and nationally. We finish by recognising issues of justice, rights and responsibilities in their own setting and the wider world.
